- Stock selection from a global equity universe encompasses developed and emerging market equities.
- Active theme rotation seeks to maximise investment opportunities that are created when market value underestimates growth and profit potential.

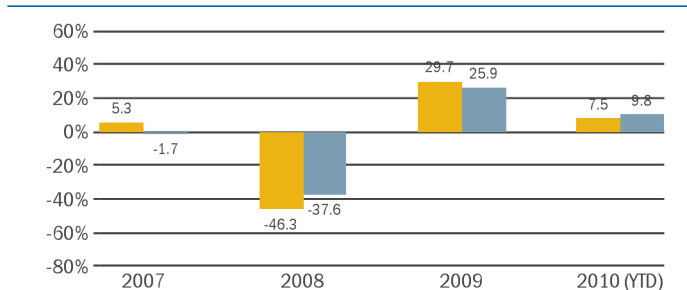

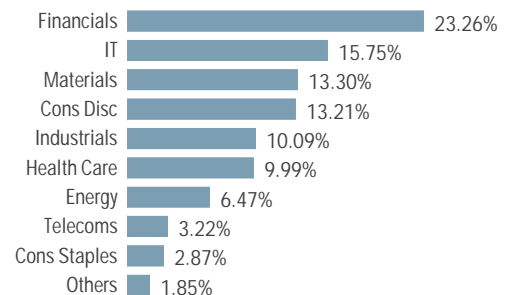

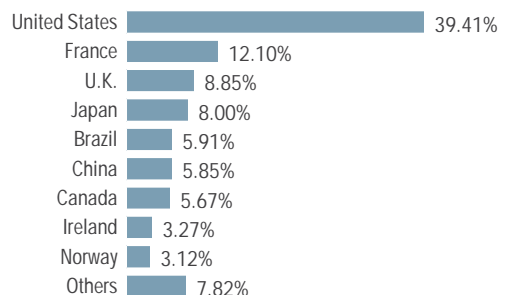

Investment Process

Step 1 – Idea Generation

- Global fundamental and quantitative research teams provide core input.
- Individual stock ideas help to identify and develop theme-driven investment opportunities.

Step 2 – Fundamental Research

- Fundamental Research Analysts conduct rigorous, in-depth company analysis centred around meetings with the company's management teams.
- Standardised research templates facilitate comparisons of companies on a global basis.
- Proprietary Discounted Cash Flow (DCF) modelling is the main valuation tool, complemented by traditional multiple-based valuations.

Step 3 – Security Selection

- Final stock selection decisions depend on fundamental valuation.
- Selected companies must exhibit clear valuation upside, which is then expected to be realised as the identified global trend plays out.
- The Portfolio Manager has sole responsibility for security selection in the Portfolio.

Step 4 – Portfolio Construction

- Unconstrained Portfolio construction approach designed to deliver focused exposure to various global themes.
- Portfolio assets will be allocated mostly towards secular themes, with tactical themes (less than 1-year investment horizon) representing a smaller proportion of assets.
- The Portfolio typically contains approximately 60 - 90 holdings.
- Portfolio construction ensures adequate diversity among trends, balancing early-stage with maturing trends.

Pioneer Funds – Global Trends is managed by lead Portfolio Manager Andrea Salvatori. He has been a member of the Global Equity team since 1999. Prior to joining Pioneer Investments in 1999, Andrea worked with UBS and with JP Morgan as an Assistant Portfolio Manager.
